DIRECTIONS

By car:

Coming from Cologne, you drive past - Aachen - Lüttich (= Liège, Luik) on the motorway **E40** heading towards Brussels. In Brussels, you head for “**Institutions Européennes**” and take the correspondent exit. You drive into a tunnel. Leaving the tunnel, you find yourself directly on Rue Cortenbergh. Go straight to the roundabout „**Rondpoint Schuman**“ and take the 2nd exit (Rue de la Loi). The 2nd street on your right-hand side is Rue du Taciturne, ca. 400 meters after Rondpoint Schuman. You find the FES in Rue du Taciturne on your left-hand side after the first crossroad.

By train:

Arriving by ICE or Thalys you step off at **Brussels-Midi**. You then take the **Metro 2** (direction “Simonis”) until the stop **Arts-loi** and then the **Metro 1A** (direction “Herrmann-Debroux”) or the Metro 1B (direction “Stockel”). Get off Metro 1A/B at the stop **Schuman**. At Schuman station take the exit “Berlaymont”. Arriving upstairs, follow Rue de la Loi downwards for about 100m and take the next street on your right which is Rue du Taciturne. You’ll find the FES Office in Rue due Taciturne on your left-hand side after the first crossroad.

By plane:

From **Brussels International Airport** (Zaventem) take the airport bus lines (on weekdays n° 12, Saturday and Sunday n° 11) to the stop **Schuman**. From the roundabout, go to **Rue de la Loi** and then take the 2nd street on your right-hand side – Rue du Taciturne. You’ll find the FES Office in Rue due Taciturne on your left-hand side after the first crossroad.

From **Charleroi Airport**, there is a bus shuttle service to Brussels’ southern train station (Bruxelles Midi). To reach the FES, see directions “by train”. You can buy tickets at a counter in the arrival hall of the Charleroi airport.
